



Access to WiFi

Internet Access Guidelines

WiFi access to the internet is available to all Library Members who agree to respect these guidelines.

For access to the internet see the Librarians.

Access is available only during the opening hours of the Library.

Library staff is not able to provide technical assistance or resolve problems if laptops fail to connect to the internet.

The Library assumes no responsibility for eventual damage to laptops resulting from connection to the Library's wireless network.

Rules for users

Current legislation regarding the use of the internet must be respected. The user is directly responsible, under the applicable laws, for the use made of the internet connection.

The Library reserves the right to report any illegal activity to the relevant authority.

Users must up-date the antivirus software on their laptops before connecting to the Library's wireless network.

The use of the internet must be limited to study purposes only. The following are not permitted:

- social networking (Facebook, Twitter, MSN, etc.)
- use of open source file-sharing software (Torrent, Emule, etc.)
- accessing video-sharing websites (Youtube, etc.).

Users must comply with copyright regulations, publishers' licence terms and protected access.

Downloading data from the internet onto laptops is not permitted as this may affect the speed of the internet connection.

Electronic resources with limited access (JStor, e-journals etc.) can only be consulted on the four terminals in the Catalogue Room. Articles can be downloaded from these sites using *Laccess* (see instructions for use next to the terminals). These terminals must not be used for general internet searches.

It is forbidden to change, remove or damage the configuration of the Library's terminals.

Compensation will be charged for any eventual damage to the equipment.
